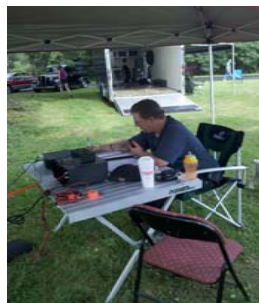
WARA Special Events 2011

Recipe of the month~ SPICEY BAKED BEANS

From the Kitchen of: Mike & Mary Gamber

Prep Time: 30mins

Category: Baked

Beans Servings: 12-15

INGREDIENTS

1 can pork - n-beans

1lb.sausage - any kind

1 can tomato soup

1 tbs Dijon mustard

Bacon strips

1 can butter beans, drained

1 cup light brown sugar -firmly packed

1 sweet onion

1 stalk celery - sliced

1 can dark red kidney ,drained

1 can spicy chili beans

1 can wax beans, drained

1 can green beans, drained

You can substitute Garbanzo beans or Northern beans for any of the drained beans listed in the ingredients.

DIRECTIONS: Brown sausage with celery in skillet. Combine beans, sausage, tomato soup, mustard & brown sugar in a baking dish. Lay uncooked bacon strips on top. Bake at 350 for 90 minutes. Crock pot for 4 to 6 hours. To "kick it up" a bit, sprinkle chili powder and Red Hot sauce over all.

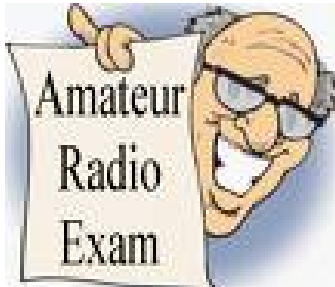
