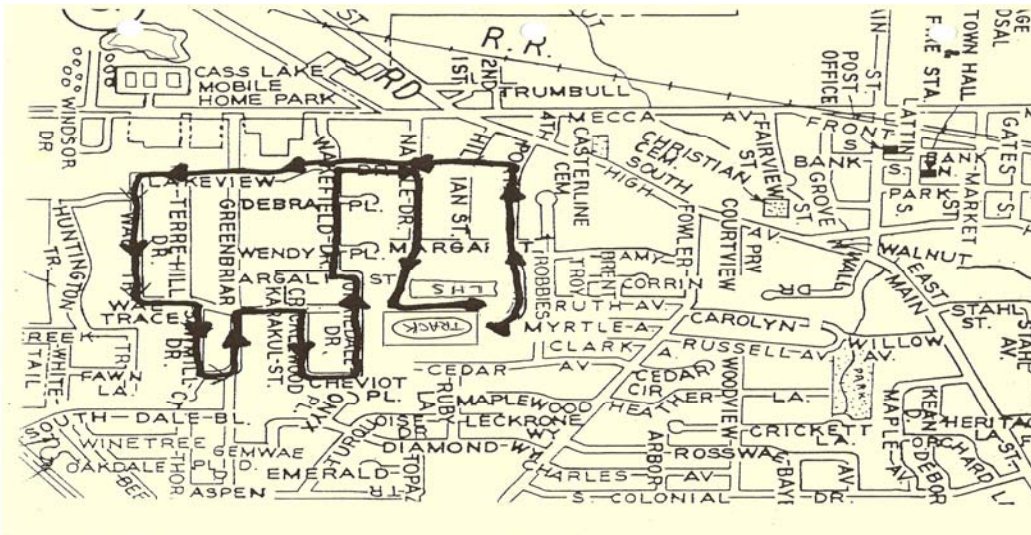

Recipe of the month~ Black Bean & Corn Salad

Ingredients:

- 1/2 cup balsamic vinaigrette dressing
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper
- 1 tablespoon chopped fresh cilantro
- 1/8 teaspoon cayenne pepper
- 1/4 teaspoon cumin
- 2cans (15oz each) black beans, drained, rinsed
- 1 can(11oz) whole kernel sweet corn
- 1 small onion, chopped (1/2 cup)
- 8 medium green onions chopped (1/2 cup)
- 1 small red bell pepper chopped(1/2cup)



Directions:

1. In a small bowl, mix together vinaigrette, seasoned pepper, cilantro, cayenne pepper, and cumin. Set dressing aside.
2. In a large bowl, stir together beans, corn, onion, green onions, and red bell pepper. Toss with dressing. Cover, and refrigerate overnight. Toss again before serving

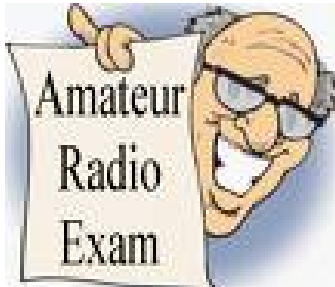
